A Holy Moment

Sermon Series: The Book of Ephesians Sermon Title: "The Power of Knowing God"

Quick Review: What stood out to you most from what you heard or read in this weekend's message?

Main Idea: Head knowledge, about God, moves to heart transformation when you practice living out true faith, which is revealed through love.

Scripture: Ephesians 1:15-23, Galatians 5:6, 1 John 3:16-18, Matthew 22:37-40, James 2:19, John 5:39-40, Psalm 34:8

Questions

- 1. Pastor Juan shared Galatians 5:6, and said that genuine faith is demonstrated through love, not just religious observance. How does this revelation change your perspective on what it really means to have faith?
- 2. Pastor Juan shared this list of signs that show we are growing in our relationship with God:
 - 1. Hear His voice more clearly
 - 2. Trust more, even in times of uncertainty
 - 3. See His hand in our daily lives
 - 4. Respond out of faith and not fear

Choose one from the list and share a specific "experience" example that illustrates your growth in your relationship with God.

3. Pastor Juan said that every "no" to the flesh is a "yes" to the promises of God. What is one recent "no" to your flesh that you have acted on? How did God move in response to it?

Challenge for the Week

You can have facts/theology about God, but if what you believe doesn't change or transform your life, you are lacking relationship with God (needing to become one with His word/ to know Him intimately). This week, choose one action and do it, to draw closer to God and His word.
